Regular City Council Meeting
Tuesday, March 20, 2018

Mayor Baker called the regular Spicer City Council meeting to order Tuesday, March 20, 2018 at 5:30 p.m. Council members present: Troy Block, Jesse Gislason, Shelly Munyon and Robin deCathelineau. Administrator/ EDA Director's Report:


