

Site Plan for a Fence Permit: A site plan is a drawing of your property showing the property lines and any structures that currently exist on that land and where your proposed fence is to be located. **A complete site plan must be submitted with your fence permit application.**

Site plan for a Fence Permit must include the following to be considered complete:

- An arrow indicating north
- Property Pins must be located and site staked for review
- Adjacent streets shown
- Indicate any easements
- A clear indication of the proposed fence
- Indicate the distance of fence from property line (must be 24 inches unless written permission from neighboring property owner)
- Type of Fence material (fill in here) _____
- Height of fence (Maximum height for residential fence is 6ft in side and rear yards. Corner lots: street side of fence maximum fence height 42 inches in the corner area 20 feet both directions from the corner property line)
